A no-cost energy assessment can put you on the path to lower energy bills and improved energy performance.

▶ Who is Eligible for a Free Energy Assessment

Small business and not-for-profit organizations in New York State that:

- Have 10 or fewer full-time employees or full-time equivalents.
- If demand charge is on the electric bill, average demand over the past 12 months must be under 100 kW

▶ What the Energy Assessment Does for You

- Provides impartial, objective recommendations for energy efficiency improvement opportunities.
- Installing measures identified in an energy assessment may help to lower utility costs and increase occupant comfort in the building.
- Support, in the forms of cash back and low interest financing, are available to qualified applicants for the implementation of cost-effective energy efficiency improvements.

▶ What is Included in the Energy Assessment

- Utility bill consumption analysis (electric and fuel).
- Evaluation of interior and exterior lighting.
- Inspection of heating, cooling, and hot water systems.
- Building envelope evaluation.
- Evaluation of refrigeration equipment and other energy consuming equipment.
- Identification of energy saving strategies.

▶ Your Obligations

- Provide 12 months of utility history (electricity and fuel).
- Provide access to areas of the building for the energy assessor at the time of the site visit.
- The organization receiving the Energy Assessment is under NO OBLIGATION to implement any of the recommendations.
